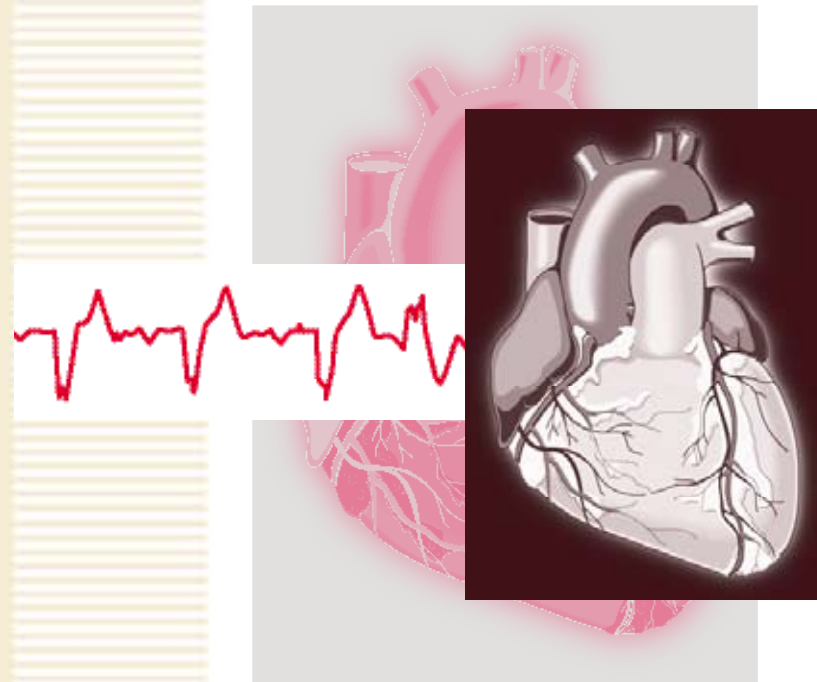

Course Description

Designed for the primary care physician, this day-long course will explore recent developments in cardiology. Topics will include congestive heart failure, lipid control therapy, pre-operative cardiac evaluation before non-cardiac surgery, atrial fibrillation, acute coronary syndrome, and practical clinical decision making in a case presentation format. Course enrollment will be limited to 70 participants.

Course Objectives

At the conclusion of this program, participants should be able to:

- Discuss the optimal medical regimen for congestive heart failure;
- Review treatment options and targets for preventing cardiovascular disease;
- Identify the role of coronary CT angiography in current practice;
- Assess and modify cardiac risk in patients undergoing non-cardiac surgery;
- Discuss the role of medical therapy and revascularization in chronic CAD;
- Describe recent developments in managing atrial fibrillation; and
- Identify the risks of PFO and the current indications and options for closure.

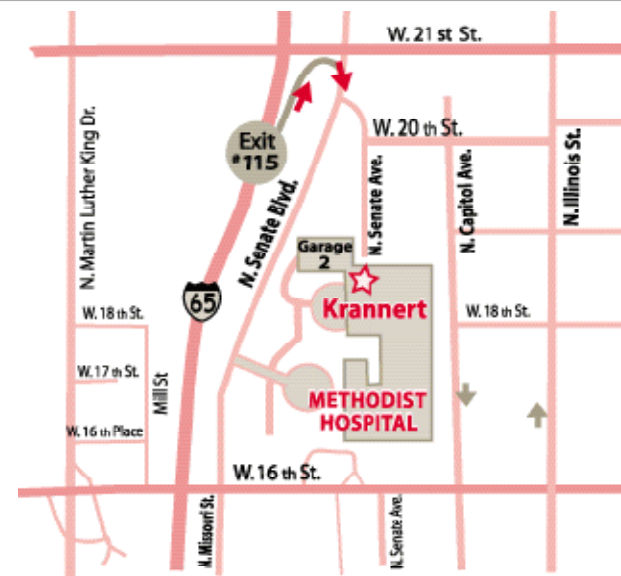
